25	Number 6, request for approval to pay

1	Court Reporter's Clearinghouse for \$526 from the Harris
2	County Bail Bond Board account for the services rendered
3	on Tuesday, October 9th, 2018.
4	Probably two years ago for those of
5	that are just joining us we elected to let the
6	Sheriff's Department's pay all bills under \$500. If
7	there was a bill that was over \$500, they had to bring
8	this to the Bail Bond Board for approval; hence this.
9	And that October 9th was a long meeting.
10	Right, Sergeant?
11	SERGEANT DELEON: Yes, sir. It was a long
12	meeting. It ran over with a with a new license and
13	so it was over \$500 so we need approval from the Board.
14	MR. BUTERA: Just for just quickly for
15	everyone else to note. That account is for the Bail
16	Bond Board to use, right? We went to the Commissioners
17	Court a while ago and there's funds set aside. And it's
18	funded by application fees by sureties applying to
19	SERGEANT DELEON: Correct.
20	MR. BUTERA: So we're sort of paying for
21	our own existence out of that account so
22	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Right.
23	MR. OSBORNE: Just out of curiosity. Do
24	we
25	Are we normally four of five months I

1	mean, is that typical to be paying
2	SERGEANT DELEON: Yes.
3	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: We normally
4	don't see these bills.
5	SERGEANT DELEON: Right.
6	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: But because this
7	one is over the 500. That's why it came here.
8	SERGEANT DELEON: It normally pays
9	normally pays automatically and it's normally like two
10	months behind. So it goes and it gets automatically
11	paid, generated. It's just when it runs over, then we
12	have to put it to the Board so then it is going to be
13	maybe three four months behind, yes, sir.
14	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Chair will
15	entertain a motion.
16	MR. BUTERA: Motion.
17	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: I have a motion
18	by Mr. Butera.
19	HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: Second.
20	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Second. Any
21	discussion?
22	All those in favor, signify by saying
23	aye.
24	THE BOARD: Aye.
25	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Any opposed?

1	Okay. Number 7, request by Sergeant
2	DeLeon for approval of 130 cases of bail bonds totalling
3	\$6,162 to be paid from the Bail Bond Board account.
4	Copy of the budget report is attached.
5	We discussed sometime ago about paying
6	for the bail bonds out of the monies that we collect for
7	license fees.
8	Any questions? Chair will entertain.
9	MR. BUTERA: Motion.
10	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: I have a motion
11	by Mr. Butera.
12	MS. KASE: Second.
13	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: I have a second.
14	Any discussion?
15	All those in favor, signify by saying aye.
16	THE BOARD: Aye.
17	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Any opposed?
18	Discussion on alternative day and time for
19	the Bail Bond Board meetings. Bail Bond Board meetings
20	follows Commissioner's Court meeting for the remainder
21	of the year.
22	Obviously, there is an issue there 'cause
23	they are going long these days. Discussion. We could
24	move the meeting forward but not backward 'cause it
25	would effect licenses.

1	So the question that this Board has to
2	consider is: Do we want to move to a Wednesday or a
3	Thursday? And if so, what time?
4	We're holding the meetings at 1:30 now
5	because number of years back, Don Jackson, we were
6	holding the meetings 2:00 then and Don Jackson Judge
7	Jackson wanted to move it back to 1:30 for his
8	particular docket and everyone agreed to do that.
9	So what do you think about moving the
10	meeting to Thursday or Wednesday and at what time?
11	SERGEANT DELEON: So just a notation on
12	that. We
13	The Sheriff's Office did contact the
14	entity that oversees the county courts room on the 9th
15	floor and we were able to secure a 1:30 for Wednesday
16	and for Thursday. If any other times or dates are
17	agreed upon we're trying to keep it in the same week
18	that we have it now then we will have to confirm.
19	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Sure.
20	SERGEANT DELEON: But the only two that
21	we've confirmed were Wednesday
22	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Sure.
23	SERGEANT DELEON: Thursday time.
24	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Sure. So what's
25	the Board's pleasure?

1	MR. OSBORNE: Is it merely a space issue?
2	We just want to use the courtroom because it's bigger?
3	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: It's easier to
4	get into
5	We normally have a lot of people that
6	come to these things and we've got other people here and
7	whatnot.
8	SERGEANT DELEON: And it's set up with a
9	recording device and a mic
LO	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Yeah.
11	SERGEANT DELEON: He's right.
12	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Everything is
13	set up.
L4	SERGEANT DELEON: The venue is much better
15	than holding in order to have their proceedings.
16	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: So the question
L7	as I understand it is Wednesday or Thursday?
18	HONORABLE GARCIA: I like Thursday.
L9	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: You like
20	Thursday.
21	HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: I'm leaning towards
22	Wednesday because I usually have a trial docket in the
23	afternoon of Thursday.
24	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Okay. Anybody
25	else?

1	MS. SNIVELY: Wednesday.
2	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: On Wednesday.
3	Anybody else?
4	HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: I'm leaning towards
5	Wednesday, is what I meant.
6	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Pardon me?
7	HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: I'm leaning towards
8	Wednesday.
9	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Okay.
10	MS. KASE: So it would be the second
11	Wednesday?
12	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Yes. Judge
13	Garcia, do you have any issues with Wednesday?
14	HONORABLE GARCIA: No. We can move our
15	judge's meeting.
16	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Do we want to
17	keep it at 1:30 or do we want to move it to 2:00?
18	MR. OSBORNE: I just assume to get it over
19	with.
20	MS. KASE: Me, too.
21	MS. SNIVELY: 1:30.
22	HONORABLE GARCIA: 1:30.
23	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: So the Chair
24	will entertain a motion to move the monthly meeting of
25	the Harris County Bail Bond Board to the second

1	Wednesday of each month at 1:30.
2	HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: For one year, Chair?
3	For one year?
4	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Period.
5	HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: Okay.
6	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Forever.
7	MR. OSBORNE: I'll make a motion.
8	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: I have a motion.
9	MS. SNIVELY: Second.
10	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: And a second.
11	Any discussion?
12	All those in favor, signify by saying aye.
13	THE BOARD: Aye.
14	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Uh?
15	MALE: Starting next month?
16	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Yes.
17	So that's going to be Thursday no.
18	Wednesday at 1:30.
19	This is a discussion on a Petition in
20	Condemnation of a property owned by Catherine Joy
21	Scroggins received by the Bail Bond Board. The property
22	was used for collateral to write bonds in Harris County
23	by Joy Scroggins.
24	Two days before the last Bail Bond Board
25	meeting, I was served a petition and it's Harris County

suing the Harris County Bail Bond Board, left hand suing 1 the right hand. And I immediately contacted our 2 attorney, Tom, and Mr. Butera and made them aware of it. 3 And this stems from a license that was in the 1980s and 4 a piece of property. 5 Tom, would you like to briefly address 6 7 that? Sure. 8 MR. RAMSEY: And I'd be happy to -if the Board wants to talk about it in executive session 9 10 I'm happy to do that. I don't think they are particularly sensitive issues. 11 VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: 12 MR. RAMSEY: So I'm also okay with doing it 13 14 in an open meeting. VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: 15 Okav. 16 MR. RAMSEY: Essentially, this is a condemnation proceeding. It was filed by the county 17 involving a piece of land that was -- that -- where a 18 deed of trust was executed in the favor of the Bail Bond 19 Board (inaudible.) The --2.0 There's been some issues in this case. 2.1 It seems like that the folks that filed the petition are 22 trying to sort out who may be the heir or current owner 23 of the property. And so how that affects the timing of 2.4 everything is still up in the air. 25

1	But the short of it is they appointed the
2	three commissioners who will set a value to the
3	property. There isn't any action required until that
4	value is set and then to the extent there would be any
5	objections to the value. I haven't personally seen that
6	in these types of cases for the position the Board is in
7	but that's (inaudible.) when we get there.
8	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: But we're good
9	to go?
10	MR. RAMSEY: Yes.
11	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Yes, sir?
12	MS. OSBORNE: What's our dog in the fight?
13	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: The Bail Bond
14	Board these people put up real property as
15	collateral and obviously, Mr. Butera would probably
16	know this. They had to take the property for Bail Bond
17	forfeitures and they're wanting to take it for property,
18	for condemnation.
19	MR. OSBORNE: So we're claiming it for
20	because it was the Bail Bond.
21	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Bail Bond Board,
22	yeah.
23	MR. OSBORNE: It was
24	SERGEANT DELEON: Right.
25	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Yes.

1	MR. OSBORNE: Okay.
2	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Yes.
3	MR. BUTERA: So it was put up as collateral
4	when they got the right to license the license to
5	post bail. And now, another county is looking to use
6	the property for
7	SERGEANT DELEON: Correct.
8	MR. BUTERA: public use.
9	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Any other
10	discussion?
11	HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: I just wanted to note
12	that's one of the ways that you secure
13	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Right.
14	HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: the collateral.
15	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Right.
16	MR. RAMSEY: Just one other note, where in
17	case anyone's wondering how many zeros, you know, behind
18	the value of the property and we're talking about
19	something that currently has an appraised value of
20	probably I think it'd be a little more, a little less
21	than a thousand dollars. Whether there are any tax
22	liens, it doesn't appear that there are any on the
23	property, whether the current taxes will be taken out of
24	that, it's all up in the air. But it's a the sum
25	total is relatively small.

VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: 1 Okay. Anybody else? Any other discussion? 2 I'm going back to the item on the agenda 3 4 that I had jumped over on the new business. Number one, election of the Harris County 5 Bail Bond Board officers for 2019. We always elect a 6 7 chair and a vice chair. Before we do this, I'd like to point out 8 two things. Your previous Board did you guys a real 9 10 favor. We voted back in October, I believe it was, to have an attorney by the name of Roger Moore who teaches 11 CE classes for the bonding company. Those classes are 12 eight hours long. He's got it hone down to things that 13 don't pertain to the Bail Bond Board and it's a 14 four-hour class. It's cost \$750. The previous Board 15 16 authorized it. We've done this in the past. Roger goes around all over Texas to 17 different Boards and teaches them this, brings you up to 18 speed on what the laws are. It's really a good class. 19 It's been approved. All we have to do is set the date 2.0 and Roger will come in and it's going to be four hours 2.1 of your time. So I just wanted to tell you that. 22 And the second thing is, is Mike Fields 23 2.4 was the previous Chairman of the Board. And last month -- or in December rather -- Mike Fields did 25

Τ	endorse me to be the next chair because of my knowledge
2	and length of time I've been sitting on the Board which
3	is 16 years.
4	So having said that, we have the election
5	to the Harris County Bail Bond officers. And Chair will
6	entertain a motion for chair.
7	SERGEANT DELEON: Is there any reason not
8	to have a Bail Bond Board
9	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: No.
10	MR. BUTERA: No. So historically, Glenn
11	has been on the Board a long time. I've not been here
12	nearly that long. But for quite a while, I think we've
13	traditionally had a judicial chair for various reasons,
14	I suppose. They're a judge. They adjudicate things and
15	typically run proceedings and Glenn has been the vice
16	chair
17	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: I was Chair for
18	one of those years.
19	MR. BUTERA: Okay.
20	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: And then I
21	stepped aside for one of the judges who came in with a
22	judge with knowledge and knew what we were doing and
23	was okay with me. A bondsman is chair in Dallas and in
24	Lubbock. Nothing precludes it. It's experience that
25	goes into it and knowledge of what's going on.

1	You've got to consider, there's
2	80-something bail bond licenses out there and the
3	employees that work for them. And their livelihood
4	depends on what this Board does or doesn't do. And so
5	you really have to understand what the laws are and what
6	the nuances are.
7	And he's correct. It's always been a
8	judicial officer. But we've never been in a situation
9	like we are today where we have newly elected judges
10	that have never sat on this Board or dealt with any of
11	it. So it is totally the Board's pleasure.
12	MR. BUTERA: But we'll say under the code,
13	the Board has enumerated powers. There's no power that
14	vest in the chairman in particularly.
15	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Yeah.
16	MR. BUTERA: Or chair personally or vise
17	chairperson. It's just kind of a running of the
18	meeting. I would just, you know
19	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: I can't
20	My salary does not double. I promise you
21	that, okay. And it's not like the chair can go and say
22	write me a check or do this or do that. It's simply
23	running this meeting and keeping things going. That's
24	all it is.
25	HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: A comment vice chair.

1	I checked into what you were saying about
2	nothing precluding you serving as chair and I will say
3	that I concur. It's my understanding that there is
4	nothing that precludes him serving as chair; although,
5	it is true that traditionally it is a judicial position.
6	So the rule is clear as far as technically.
7	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: So what's the
8	Board's pleasure?
9	MR. OSBORNE: I make a motion to appoint
10	you as Chair.
11	HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: I'll second.
12	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: I have a motion
13	and a second for me, Glenn Strickland, to be Chair.
14	Any discussion? Is there any other
15	nominations?
16	Do you have a motion to elect by
17	acclamation?
18	MS. KASE: So moved.
19	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: I have a motion
20	to elect by acclamation.
21	All those in favor, signify by saying
22	aye.
23	THE BOARD: Aye.
24	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Any opposed?
25	Thank you very much, I think.

1	MR. OSBORNE: If you're a sucker to do
2	it
3	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: You know what
4	I'm saying? The next is going to be vice chair and the
5	vice chair sits in with the chair and presides whenever
6	the chair can't been there.
7	You still have to have a knowledge of
8	what's going on and not necessarily an investigative arm
9	such as Mr. Butera is an investigative arm. Sheriff's
10	Department is an investigative arm. So they're out.
11	So what is the Board's pleasure for a
12	vice chair?
13	MR. BUTERA: I'll just say we're not out
14	for any legal reason.
15	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: No.
16	MR. BUTERA: I'm not seeking to be the vice
17	chair and I don't think
18	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: No. And you're
19	right.
20	MR. BUTERA: So I am completely fine not
21	doing it.
22	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: You're right.
23	MR. BUTERA: But there's nothing that
24	preclude either the Sheriff's Office
25	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: That is correct.

1	MR. BUTERA: (Inaudible.)
2	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: That is a
3	hundred percent correct.
4	HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: I am open to it if
5	the Board feels that they want me to serve this year,
6	but I'm not pushing either way.
7	HONORABLE GARCIA: Can a delicate or it has
8	to be
9	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: No.
10	HONORABLE GARCIA: It has to be Judge
11	Marshall, right?
12	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Yeah.
13	MR. BUTERA: What's the basis for that,
14	Glenn?
15	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Well, I thought
16	we had discussed that a designee could not sit in the
17	chair. It had to be the person elected.
18	MR. OSBORNE: I would be more comfortable
19	with that, frankly.
20	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Yeah.
21	MR. OSBORNE: I mean, honestly if the
22	principals don't want to show up, I'm not voting for
23	them.
24	VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Yeah.
25	MR. MCKINNEY: If it helps anybody, I've

served in that position before on this Board. 1 MR. OSBORNE: How was it? Too much to it, 2 3 honestly? MR. MCKINNEY: I chaired at one meeting. 4 MR. OSBORNE: I'd make a motion to do Ms. 5 Rod -- Judge Rodriguez. 6 7 VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Judge Rodriguez. HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: Let's discuss. It is 8 possible for you to serve as vice chair this year? 9 10 Are you interested? VICE CHAIRMAN STRICKLAND: Except he's not 11 here at this meeting. 12 HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: All right. 13 MR. BUTERA: Well, he is a public attendee 14 of the meeting. 15 16 MR. MCKINNEY: I'm a public member right 17 now. HONORABLE GARCIA: I'm not going to vote on 18 somebody's who's not at this meeting. 19 HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: Because if you're 2.0 interested in serving this year, Mr. Troy, I would yield 21 22 to you. MR. MCKINNEY: It's totally up to the 23 2.4 Board. I've done it before. If you want me, I'll do it If you don't, I'm fine with that, too. 25 again.
