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P R O C E E D I N G S

MR. BUTERA: All right. Good afternoon.

It is Wednesday, May the 8th at 1:31 p.m. We are without either a chair or a vice chair. So without any objection or if someone else wants to do it, I'll just run through the agenda; but if someone else wants to step in, you're more than welcome to.

So let's get started off by -- we don't have a court reporter but we are recording the meeting per the statute requirements.

So let's get started by identifying -- letting everyone identify themselves for the record starting with the Sheriff's Office.

CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: I am Captain Angela Ordonez. I'm filling in for Captain Curtis Ruggles who's the voting Member.

MR. OSBORNE: Dylan Osborne, County Treasurer.

HONORABLE GARCIA: Judge Esmeralda Pena Garcia for the City.

MR. BUTERA: Michael Butera for the District Attorney's Office.

MR. PASTOR: Billy Pastor for the bail bondsmen representing Glenn Strickland.

MS. SNIVELY: Judith Snively for the Harris

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1 County District Clerk.

2 MR. BUTERA: Very good. The first item of
3 business on the agenda number or letter A is the reading
4 of the prior minutes.

5 Has everyone had a chance to look at the
6 minutes? And do we have a motion to approve them?

7 MR. OSBORNE: A motion to approve them.

8 HONORABLE GARCIA: I second.

9 MR. BUTERA: All right. Since we're on an
10 audio recording, if everyone will identify themselves.

11 So that was Mr. Osborne moving the
12 minutes and Judge Garcia to second that.

13 All approve, please say aye.

14 THE BOARD: Aye.

15 MR. BUTERA: Any no's?

16 All right. So the minutes are approved.

17 All right. Moving to old business.

18 B. Item No. 1, request made by Bankers Insurance Group,
19 Agent Kevin O'Brien doing business as Bail Bond
20 Services, License No. 74486 to return the secure deposit
21 for Bankers Insurance Group, CD No. TR357319 in the
22 amount of \$50,000. JP letters were made on 3/11 of
23 2019.

24 And we have someone at the podium. Could
25 you identify yourself for the record?

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1 MR. JOHNSON: Sure. My name is Drew
2 Johnson. I'm the corporate rep and attorney for Bankers
3 Insurance.

4 MR. BUTERA: All right. And if you would
5 raise your right hand, please.

6 (Witness sworn.)

7 MR. BUTERA: All right. Very good.
8 Anything from the sheriff's department or any other
9 members?

10 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: Yes. The Sheriff's
11 Office has -- this is Captain Ordenez with the Sheriff's
12 Office.

13 We have received no notification of
14 liabilities owed to any justice of the peace. We know
15 of no reason the CD cannot be released.

16 MR. BUTERA: All right. Anyone else around
17 the table? I'll say we've also done a check. I don't
18 show any pending judgments either on that license or for
19 Bankers. They've all been paid so ...

20 Anyone have a motion?

21 MR. PASTOR: Motion. Bill Pastor.

22 MR. BUTERA: All right. And a second?

23 HONORABLE GARCIA: Second, Judge Garcia.

24 MR. BUTERA: All right. All those in
25 favor, please say aye.

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1 THE BOARD: Aye.

2 MR. BUTERA: Anyone opposed, no?

3 All right. The ayes have it.

4 MR. JOHNSON: Thank you.

5 MR. BUTERA: It will be returned.

6 All right. Item No. 2, a request made by
7 Felix Kubosh doing business as Kubosh Bail Bonding,
8 License No. 74386 to release property at 1619 Lubbock
9 Street, Houston, Texas 77007. JP letters were mailed on
10 3/28 of 2019.

11 Mr. Kubosh, how are you doing?

12 MR. KUBOSH: I'm fine.

13 MR. BUTERA: Good. Would you raise your
14 right hand?

15 MR. KUBOSH: Yes.

16 (Witness sworn.)

17 MR. BUTERA: Very good. All right. Around
18 the table.

19 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: Yes. Angela Ordonez with
20 the Sheriff's Office. The Sheriff's Office will refer
21 to the DA's designee, Michael Butera, for an update on
22 the outstanding liabilities.

23 MR. BUTERA: Very good. Mr. Kubosh, we
24 visited or I briefly mentioned before the meeting, I did
25 check up on the license again. We've made some progress

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1 since the last meeting. There were three cases we were
2 able to dispose of that have since been taken care of.
3 One of the cases is in a final status and needs to be
4 paid but you were visiting with me and you said you
5 think that's been taken care of.

6 MR. KUBOSH: It's online. It shows paid.

7 MR. BUTERA: Okay. We'll double check
8 that. And then here are four cases remaining that are
9 all sort of in the same status or similar status where
10 the defendant has not yet been returned.

11 MR. KUBOSH: AWR.

12 MR. BUTERA: Yes, sir. So that's just a
13 designation we use, meaning we knew the defendant was
14 here at one point. We're awaiting their return, is what
15 we say, AWR.

16 MR. KUBOSH: I would ask you to either
17 table it one more time so I can see if I can come up
18 with a solution or just -- unless you would rather than
19 I just set another meeting or get on the agenda for a
20 later date, whichever you would rather do. It'd like
21 for you to just table it just to give me one more shot.

22 MR. BUTERA: That's fine. But I mean, I
23 have no objection to that. If someone wants to make a
24 motion to table to see if we can ...

25 HONORABLE GARCIA: Judge Garcia. I make a

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1 motion to table this request.

2 MR. BUTERA: Is there a second?

3 MR. OSBORNE: Dylan Osborne, second.

4 MR. BUTERA: And all those in favor, please
5 say aye.

6 THE BOARD: Aye.

7 MR. BUTERA: Anyone opposed? All right.
8 So we will table that --

9 MR. KUBOSH: Thank you. And thank you for
10 working on this with me and helping me. I appreciate
11 it. Thank you very much.

12 MR. BUTERA: We will continue to do that.
13 Sorry. So I don't think it was part of the motion to
14 table for a certain length. I think our common practice
15 is when something is tabled, it's to the next agenda.

16 Do you want to clarify for the record?

17 HONORABLE GARCIA: Yes. My motion is to
18 table it to the next meeting.

19 MR. BUTERA: Okay. And do you want a
20 second?

21 MR. OSBORNE: Second.

22 MR. BUTERA: All right. And so I see we'll
23 have the same result, but all those in favor, please say
24 aye.

25 THE BOARD: Aye.

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1 MR. BUTERA: All right. Does anyone
2 oppose?

3 Very good. So we will carry that to the
4 June meeting.

5 All right. So moving on to new business,
6 Number 1 is a request made by IFIC Glenn
7 Strickland, Chairman, to correct the March minutes, Item
8 No. 2 under new business. Correction was made to
9 reflect Glenn Strickland not seconding the motion made
10 by Judge Esmeralda Pena Garcia.

11 Glenn's not here. I think that's pretty
12 clear. So it's just a change. It was in my packet to
13 change those in the previous minutes.

14 Does anyone have a motion to that effect?

15 MR. OSBORNE: So was there a second?
16 Esmeralda Pena ...

17 MR. BUTERA: So it says -- in the change,
18 it just says motion to approve by Judge Esmeralda Pena
19 Garcia, motion carried. There -- I know there was a
20 second or we wouldn't have moved on but not having a
21 reporter's record, I don't know who the second was made
22 by. Is that correct?

23 We could table till the next agenda
24 perhaps to see if we can't tell from the recording who
25 the second was made by just to clarify the record.

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1 MR. OSBORNE: Yes. If there was a mistake
2 made on the second or a motion, would that invalidate
3 the action?

4 MR. BUTERA: Tommy -- no? No.

5 MR. RAMSEY: In fact, once the discussion,
6 the vote happens, the second is procedurally immaterial.

7 MR. BUTERA: I think we follow Roberts Rule
8 of Order as of, you know, in due course just to keep our
9 meetings orderly. There's no statutory requirement even
10 for the motions to being moved and seconded.

11 Is that fair to say, Tommy?

12 MR. RAMSEY: That's right. And even Robert
13 Rules provides a separate subset of rules, (inaudible.)
14 12, and in those rules, a second is not required.

15 MR. BUTERA: Okay. So that is our common
16 practice but even without it, there would be no legal
17 change to the Board's vote last time. So we could
18 proceed with just a move, no second on the minutes if
19 that would be acceptable to everyone.

20 MR. OSBORNE: All right. Well, I'll make
21 a motion to accept it, Dylan Osborne.

22 MR. BUTERA: Okay. Is there a second to --
23 just to clarify that motion -- to reflect the changes in
24 the packet, meaning that Item No. 2, new business, on
25 last month's agenda would say motion to approve by

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1 Esmeralda Pena Garcia. Motion carried with all
2 voting in favor.

3 HONORABLE GARCIA: I think he wants to
4 correct the March minutes, not last month's.

5 MR. BUTERA: Sorry. I don't have a
6 coverage sheet.

7 HONORABLE GARCIA: Yeah.

8 MR. BUTERA: So for the March minutes.

9 Okay. Very good. So is that the correct
10 motion then, to reflect Mr. Strickland's request that it
11 would just read there was a motion made by Judge Pena
12 Garcia. There is no second noted in the minutes but
13 that the motion did carry with all voting in favor.

14 MR. OSBORNE: Yes. I would make a motion
15 to accept Item 1.

16 MR. BUTERA: Okay. Is there a second?

17 MR. PASTOR: Second. Oh, go ahead.

18 MS. SNIVELY: I'll second the motion,
19 Judith Snively.

20 MR. BUTERA: All right. All those in
21 favor, please say aye.

22 THE BOARD: Aye.

23 MR. BUTERA: Any opposed? All right. That
24 request is approved.

25 Moving on to Number 2. Request for

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1 renewal of license for North River Insurance Company,
2 Agent Ayala, License No. 74527 doing business as 1-Way
3 Out Bail Bonds at 6906 Denison Street, No. A, in
4 Houston, Texas 77020. Original license date 7/12 of
5 2011. Expiration date is 7/22 of 2019. The phone
6 number is (713) 672-2663 and this is a three-year
7 renewal.

8 Would you both identify yourselves for
9 the record?

10 MR. AYALA: Jason Ayala with 1-Way Out Bail
11 Bonds.

12 MS. BROWN: Kiki Brown, vice president of
13 North River Insurance Company.

14 MR. BUTERA: All right. And if you'd both
15 raise your right hand, please.

16 (Witness sworn.)

17 MR. BUTERA: All right. Any questions from
18 the Sheriff's Department?

19 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: Yes. Angela Ordonez from
20 the Sheriff's Office. The Sheriff's Office knows of no
21 past unpaid judgments owed to Harris County as of
22 5/7/19.

23 MR. BUTERA: All right. Anyone else? I'll
24 say the same for the DA's Office. There's no issues
25 pending that would prevent the renewal from our

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1 position.

2 MR. PASTOR: Motion to approve the renewal.

3 MR. BUTERA: So the motion --

4 MR. PASTOR: Bill Pastor.

5 MR. BUTERA: Pastor. All right. Is there
6 a second?

7 HONORABLE GARCIA: Judge Garcia, second.

8 MR. BUTERA: All those in favor, please say
9 aye.

10 THE BOARD: Aye.

11 MR. BUTERA: All right. Any opposed?

12 Very good. So it's approved.

13 Congratulations.

14 MS. BROWN: Thank you.

15 MR. BUTERA: Number 3 in new business.

16 Notification was given that as of May 1, 2019 made by
17 the North River Insurance Company, Agent Jason Ayala
18 doing business as 1-Way Out Bail Bonds, License No.
19 74527 has closed the satellite office listed below at
20 1-Way Out Bail Bonds, 3749 Erie Street, Houston, Texas
21 77017.

22 All right. And that's just a notice
23 requirement under the rules so we will take notice.
24 (Inaudible.).

25 MR. AYALA: Thank you, sir.

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1 MR. BUTERA: Thank you.

2 Item No. 4, request for renewal of
3 license by Financial Casualty & Surety, Inc., Agent
4 Rodney Vannerson doing business as Aaron Bail Bonds at
5 409 Fannin Street, Houston, Texas 77002. The original
6 date was 7/8 of 2018. Expiration date: 7/18/2019.
7 License No. 74497. Phone number is (713) 223-2663 and
8 this is a three-year license renewal.

9 All right. Would you both please
10 identify yourself for the record?

11 MR. VANNERSON: Rodney Vannerson.

12 MR. PETRIOR: Darius "Petrior", assistant
13 vice president of Financial Casualty & Surety.

14 MR. BUTERA: Thank you so much. And would
15 you raise your right hand?

16 (Witness sworn.)

17 MR. BUTERA: Very good. Any questions?

18 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: Angela Ordonez with the
19 Sheriff's Office. We know of no unpaid judgments owed
20 to Harris County as of 5/7/19.

21 MR. BUTERA: Okay. Anyone else? I'll say
22 the same for the DA's Office. No unpaid judgments,
23 nothing that I can note that would stand in the way of
24 the renewal.

25 Any other discussion or a motion to

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1 approve?

2 HONORABLE GARCIA: Judge Garcia, make a
3 motion to approve.

4 MR. BUTERA: All right. Is there a second?

5 MR. OSBORNE: Dylan Osborne, second.

6 MR. BUTERA: All those in favor, say aye.

7 THE BOARD: Aye.

8 MR. BUTERA: Any opposed, no? All right.
9 It's approved. Thank you so much.

10 MR. VANNERSON: Thank you very much.

11 MR. BUTERA: And then last, we have
12 Number 5. A request for renewal of license from Carolyn
13 Campbell doing business as Capital Bail Bonds at
14 607 Houston Avenue, Houston, Texas 77007. The original
15 date was 6/14 of 1989. Expiration date is 6/24 of 2019.
16 The license number is 74264. Phone number is
17 (713) 228-1000 and this is a three-year license renewal.

18 Ms. Campbell, would you identify yourself
19 for the record?

20 MS. CAMPBELL: Carolyn Campbell.

21 MR. BUTERA: All right. And would you
22 raise your right hand, please, ma'am?

23 (Witness sworn.)

24 MR. BUTERA: Thank you. Any questions?

25 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: Yes. The Sheriff's

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1 Office has some questions. If you will refer to your
2 packet and go to page 12, please.

3 MR. BUTERA: I'll just say for the
4 record -- Judge, how are you doing?

5 HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: Hello.

6 MR. BUTERA: And we're on audio recording.
7 So since we don't have a court reporter, do you want to
8 identify for the record --

9 HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: My name is Judge
10 Angela D. Rodriguez and I am a member.

11 MR. BUTERA: Okay. Thank you, Judge.

12 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: Okay. I wait for you to
13 open your packet. Judge, we're on Capital Bail Bonds,
14 License No. 74264. We're referring to page 12 for our
15 question.

16 The personal financial statements show
17 cash on-hand listed at \$18,111.18. If you'll now go to
18 page 15, Scheduled 2, Banking Relations.

19 You have three balances totalling
20 \$11,642.53, \$6,440.92 and \$28.36 Septembers which equal
21 the total of 18,111.81. However, we only see a
22 supporting document for the 2836.

23 Knowing that these are your personal and
24 business accounts, we are aware that these balances are
25 fluid. Whoever -- however, it is safe for the County to

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1 assume that the balance currently in the accounts are
2 close to the amounts reflected on the application.

3 Did you bring supporting documentation
4 for these accounts today?

5 MS. CAMPBELL: I have supporting documents
6 in here and I'm not -- you asking for the 28?

7 One of them has changed and this is the
8 supporting document for the change on one of the
9 accounts.

10 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: I only see supporting
11 documentation for the 2836. They're looking for
12 supporting documentation for the other two listing
13 11,642.53 and 6440.92.

14 For the record, she's producing
15 documentation right now that we're trying to receive.

16 MS. CAMPBELL: That's the one that's
17 changed to this.

18 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: When the Board Members
19 are -- have reviewed the documentation, we have two more
20 questions.

21 MS. CAMPBELL: This is another one on the
22 7th (inaudible.) amount is different (inaudible.)

23 MR. BUTERA: Carolyn, before we move on to
24 something else, can I just ask a clarifying question?

25 So we're looking at your Schedule 2 which

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1 is on page 15 and it list those three accounts.

2 Do you have that in front of you just so
3 you can look at what I'm talking about so we know?

4 MS. CAMPBELL: No but I'll look at --
5 page 15?

6 MR. BUTERA: Yes, ma'am. The very top
7 chart. At the very top, says Schedule 2 Banking
8 Relations. Let me know when you're looking at that.

9 MS. CAMPBELL: Okay.

10 MR. BUTERA: So that was those three
11 accounts there that the Sheriff's Office was talking
12 about. One is from Capital Bail Bonds for \$11,000. One
13 looks like in your personal name for about \$6400 and
14 then the Pearland State Bank.

15 I think the question was: Did you have
16 supporting documentation for those two balances of
17 \$11,642 and for the 6,440?

18 MS. CAMPBELL: Well, when I -- when I did
19 this --

20 MR. BUTERA: Yes, ma'am --

21 MS. CAMPBELL: -- that's what showed up --

22 MR. BUTERA: Sure.

23 MS. CAMPBELL: -- on my account online.

24 Okay. But when I went back to print it, I
25 just gave you two different ones. One was 28,000

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1 something and one was something else.

2 MR. BUTERA: Okay. So then this -- we've
3 been hearing, it says Chase for business with a balance
4 of 62,511 --

5 MS. CAMPBELL: That's not my personal
6 account.

7 MR. BUTERA: Okay. So the one that was
8 listed previously as \$6,440.92 is now at a 62,511.99
9 balance.

10 MS. CAMPBELL: That's correct.

11 MR. BUTERA: Okay. And then the second
12 which is another Chase account with a balance of 28,000?

13 MS. CAMPBELL: That's the same account as
14 you just asked me about on the 11,000.

15 MR. BUTERA: Okay. So the previous one
16 that was listed, Capital Bail Bonds, for \$11,642.53 now
17 has a balance of \$28,699.65, okay.

18 MS. CAMPBELL: Whenever I typed -- I
19 printed it out.

20 MR. BUTERA: So those are both to the
21 positive because --

22 MS. CAMPBELL: Pardon?

23 MR. BUTERA: Those are balance increases
24 from what you had previously --

25 MS. CAMPBELL: Yes, uh-huh.

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1 MR. BUTERA: Okay.

2 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: All right. Sheriff's
3 Office has a second question.

4 If you will go to page 12 and look at
5 real estate.

6 Ms. Campbell, you have a value of
7 1,101,800 combined with three properties; however, you
8 did not provide an appraisal for any of the properties
9 listed.

10 Where did you come up with the appraisal
11 value listed on Schedule 1 Real Estate on page 13 and
12 14?

13 And do you have any other supporting
14 documents today other than what you supplied in your
15 renewal packet?

16 MS. CAMPBELL: I don't have any other than
17 what I supplied because I supplied what the insurance
18 company has them insured for. Because they came out,
19 went through. I did not have quotes appraisals and so
20 the insurance company would not lower my appraisals any
21 lower than they were. I actually lowered one of them
22 from what the appraisal is supposed to be right now to
23 what the insurance company had it which was a 141,000 on
24 "Viwater". And the Green Tea address is insured for 700
25 and some odd-thousand dollars and they came out, took

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1 pictures, went over it and said as much as they would
2 lower it to insure the house for. And was there a
3 third?

4 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: Well, the one question
5 that I just want to clarify in what you're elaborating
6 on there, is that you have no self-paid for appraisal
7 for any of those properties; is that correct? Am I
8 understanding?

9 MS. CAMPBELL: I do not have an actual
10 appraisal. I never been asked for them before. I've
11 never -- in all the years I renewed my license, I've
12 never been asked for that. So I was not aware that was
13 even to be brought up as far as actual appraisals so I
14 went by what the insurance company had them in here for.

15 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: We have a final question
16 that is not in relation to this so I'll let the
17 Board ...

18 MR. BUTERA: Do you mind?

19 Just on that point, Ms. Campbell, do you
20 know the real property appraisal records are appraising
21 those three properties at? I did not check before I --

22 MS. CAMPBELL: The real property --

23 MR. BUTERA: For tax purposes.

24 MS. CAMPBELL: -- appraisals are always
25 less than what --

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1 MR. BUTERA: Sure.

2 MS. CAMPBELL: -- what they are.

3 MR. BUTERA: Sure.

4 MS. CAMPBELL: Do I know exactly what they
5 are? No.

6 HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: Ma'am, I have a quick
7 question for you. This is Judge Rodriguez for the
8 record.

9 How long have you had your license?

10 MS. CAMPBELL: Since '89.

11 HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: Thank you.

12 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: All right. Our next
13 question is people -- if the Board will refer to
14 page 12, please, Other Assets.

15 MS. CAMPBELL: 12?

16 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: On page 12 under Other
17 Assets.

18 We noticed that the dollar amount you
19 used, 366,000, was the amount listed on an insurance
20 declaration page you provide in your packet.

21 Is this where you obtained a value of
22 your other -- the value of your other assets? Do you
23 not --

24 Did you not have to get any items
25 itemized through your insurance company?

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1 MS. CAMPBELL: No.

2 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: Okay.

3 MS. CAMPBELL: I did not.

4 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: Finally, the Sheriff's
5 Office, if there's no comments from the Board or
6 actions, we do have a final notation that I'd like to
7 read to you, if you're prepared for that now.

8 "Currently, Capital Bail Bonds is in the
9 ratio allotted with the amount of money currently on
10 file with the Harris County Treasurer's Office. The
11 Sheriff's Office knows of no past due unpaid judgments
12 owed to Harris County as of 5/7/19. Note: Yet, in this
13 case, the ratio is ten times the amount on deposit.
14 Currently, there is \$150,000 on deposit bringing the
15 ratio amount to 1.5 million that can be written in
16 bonds. She currently has over 1.4 million written in
17 bonds leaving about 88,000 available to write in bonds."

18 MR. OSBORNE: I have a question. Is the
19 collateral that's placed, is it in CDs? Is that what
20 you're saying?

21 MR. BUTERA: Is it in --

22 CAPTAIN ORDONEZ: I don't have --

23 MS. CAMPBELL: It's in CDs.

24 MR. OSBORNE: 150,000.

25 MS. CAMPBELL: Yes.

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1 MR. OSBORNE: Okay. That's all I have.

2 MR. BUTERA: Further questions from anyone
3 else? No?

4 MR. PASTOR: I have a question for you.

5 So the lack of appraisals does not appear
6 to normally been an issue but is that something we
7 expect?

8 MR. BUTERA: I think it's up to the Board
9 to scrutinize any -- particular on a property license
10 but Ms. Campbell has been a property bondsman forever --

11 MS. CAMPBELL: Yes.

12 MR. BUTERA: -- as was pointed out. So
13 she's coming back for her regular renewal. It's up to
14 the Board to look at the personal financial statement
15 just to vet that to make sure that everything is as it
16 purports to be. And so those questions I think are part
17 of that process. When you have real property up as
18 collateral --

19 Which is not the case here, right?

20 MS. CAMPBELL: No. I had cash.

21 MR. BUTERA: So it's all by CD. So the
22 actual collateral supporting the business are CDs, cash
23 money, not real property. But when you put up real
24 property, you can rely on either the appraisal -- tax
25 appraisal or a private appraisal to establish the value

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1 of that property.

2 Since the property is just part of the
3 full financial portfolio, you don't have to do that but
4 I think the questions were just how that value was
5 arrived at. And so it came forward it was through
6 insurance numbers as opposed to either of those methods.
7 But because it's not part of the collateral for the
8 license, it doesn't have to be established in the same
9 way. Just be up to the Board's discretion as to whether
10 or not that was an accurate reflection on the financial
11 payment.

12 All right. Do we have a motion?

13 MR. PASTOR: Bill Pastor, motion to approve
14 renewal.

15 HONORABLE RODRIGUEZ: Second.

16 MR. BUTERA: Second. All right. Very
17 good. Any --

18 MS. CAMPBELL: Thank you.

19 MR. BUTERA: -- other comments. All those
20 in favor, please say aye.

21 THE BOARD: Aye.

22 MS. SNIVELY: I believe we need to notate
23 who the second was for the record.

24 MR. BUTERA: Oh, I'm sorry, Judith.

25 So since we're on the audio recording, we


